

ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Each team will present on an assigned movie/video/topic. All members of the team must help in preparing slides for the presentation. Team leaders will delegate speakers for the presentation (minimum 2)

The presentation duration for each team is 13 minutes with 2 minutes for questions. Typically a 13 minute oral presentation will require 12-16 slides excluding title slide.

Your presentation must include the following:

Title slide with team member names

INTEGRATED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FOR A SELECT COUNTRY

- Indicate the geographical location, population
- What does their solid waste consist of? How much is produced?
- How is the solid waste managed?
- What laws are enforced? Taxes?
- Personal accountability
- Social/Environmental Injustices-Placement of facilities; emissions; contamination etc.

HAZARDOUS WASTE and AIR POLLUTION PRESENTATIONS

- Setting of the event; Brief information about the country/state/city etc; Include both social, economic and environmental information
- Contaminant characteristics: Chemistry and health impacts
- Conclusion: What is the moral/ethical/social value of the assigned video/movie/event? Did it impact legislation/environmental regulations etc.

GREEN ENGINEERING PRESENTATIONS

- Define Green Engineering as it pertains to your topic
- Make sure you look at your topic from a global perspective

Tips for presentation evaluation

Presentation Component	Ask yourself...	Grade (20 points max, each)
Oral Communication	Did they clearly explain their objectives? Could you hear them? Did they speak at a good rate?	
Visual Communication	Did the visuals help you to better understand the design? Were words and equations legible?	
Professionalism	Did they present in a professional manner? How did they respond to questions?	
Technical Content	Does the team have an adequate knowledge of their assigned research topic?	
Overall	Was the presentation well organized? Did they introduce and summarize?
