Content of Presentation

- Your presentation should cover the KEY POINTS such as location, special engineering features, other features related to exhibits etc. The ideal presentation is designed to (1) attract attention; (2) provide a brief overview of your work; and (3) initiate discussion and questions.
- The presentation should include an introduction, objectives of the research or project, the major findings and their significance, and conclusions. There should be a logical sequence - introduction, development, and conclusion - to your presentation.
- Visuals enhance the effectiveness of your presentation. Simplicity and legibility are more important than artistic embellishments; however, use pictures, diagrams, cartoons, figures, etc., wherever with appropriate captions.
